



Delhi – the Kaju India 2019 host city

Delhi, the capital city of India, reflects the country’s rich history and heritage. The city is also a mirror to the country’s flourishing present and promising future. Among numerous tourist attractions are the three UNESCO World Heritage Sites namely, Qutb Complex, Red Fort and Humayun’s Tomb. Agra, about 225 km by road from Delhi, is home to one of the Wonders of the World - Taj Mahal - the mausoleum known as the Monument of Love built by Shah Jahan in memory of his wife, Mumtaz Mahal.

Taj Palace

How to reach the venue:

- The Diplomatic Enclave is a 6-minute walk from the Chanakyapuri Train Station.
- Distance from Delhi International Airport - 7 km
- Easiest transportation - 8 minutes by car
- Distance from New Delhi Railway Station - 9 km
- Easiest transportation -10 minutes by car
- Distance from Chanakyapuri Train Station - 0.4 km
- Easiest transportation - 1 minute by car
