Standard Operating Protocol (SOP) for movement of Indian Nationals arriving from abroad by special flights

- All movement of special flights carrying the Indian Nationals stranded outside to West Bengal will take place through the Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose International Airport, Kolkata.
- The Standard Operating Protocol as notified by Government of India in the Ministry of Home affairs vide No 40-3/2020-DM-I (A) dated 5th May, 2020 shall be followed.
- All movements inside the airport shall be done following norms of social distancing.
- All passengers arriving at the airport shall undergo mandatory health screening at the disembarkation point as per the protocol.
- All passengers shall undergo a mandatory institutional quarantine for a minimum period of 14 days in the notified facilities for which both pay and use and government facilities shall be made available
- 6. Those passengers who do not want to avail the government facility for quarantine shall inform the same to the nodal officer in advance about the paid quarantine facility selected by them out of the list already shared after booking the same directly. They will be directed to the concerned facility only after verifying their booking receipts and will have to clear all the bills of the facility before getting discharged.
- Rest passengers will be taken to the government managed quarantine facilities.
- 8. Those testing negative after 14 days shall be allowed to go home and undertake self-monitoring of their health for a further period of 14 days as per protocol. Others will be taken to a designated health facility of the government.
- A state control room under the supervision of a senior officer shall be made operational at the NSCBI airport to monitor and facilitate the arrival of passengers.
