THE 2ND INDIA-INDONESIA SECURITY DIALOGUE

The 2nd India-Indonesia Security Dialogue (the 2nd IISD) was held earlier today in Jakarta, co-chaired by Coordinating Minister for Political, Legal and Security Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia, Mohammad Mahfud MD and National Security Adviser of the Republic of India, Ajit Doval.

The IISD is a forum that brings the Coordinating Minister for Political, Legal and Security Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia and the National Security Adviser of the Republic of India together to discuss and enhance cooperation between the two countries on political and security issues.

At the 2nd IISD, Minister Mahfud and National Security Adviser Ajit Doval discussed several shared priorities, including review of the current global and security issues, countering terrorism and violent extremism, and enhancing maritime, defence, space and cyber security cooperation.

Minister Mahfud and National Security Adviser Ajit Doval recognized the importance of traditional friendly relationship and Comprehensive Strategic Partnership between the two countries and expressed confidence that the IISD would strengthen the cooperation between them to overcome common challenges and identify opportunities for further close collaboration in the field of political and security issues.

At the meeting, Minister Mahfud and National Security Adviser Ajit Doval signed the Memorandum of Understanding for Security Dialogue between the Coordinating Ministry for Political, Legal, and Security Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia and the National Security Council Secretariat of the Republic of India.

National Security Adviser Ajit Doval conveyed his gratitude to Minister Mahfud for hosting the meeting in Indonesia and extended an invitation to host Indonesia in India to co-chair the following 3rd IISD.

National Security Adviser Ajit Doval also met Coordinating Minister for Maritime and Investment Affairs and Minister of Foreign Affairs.

DIALOG KEAMANAN INDIA-INDONESIA KE-2

Dialog Keamanan India-india ke-2 (IISD ke-2) diadakan hari ini di Jakarta, diketuai bersama oleh Menteri Koordinator Bidang Politik, Hukum, dan Keamanan Republik Indonesia, Mohammad Mahfud MD dan Penasihat Keamanan Nasional Republik India, Ajit Doval.

IISD merupakan forum yang mempertemukan Menteri Koordinator Bidang Politik, Hukum, dan Keamanan Republik Indonesia dan Penasihat Keamanan Nasional Republik India untuk membahas dan meningkatkan kerja sama kedua negara di bidang politik dan keamanan.

Pada IISD ke-2, Menteri Mahfud dan Penasihat Keamanan Nasional Ajit Doval membahas beberapa prioritas bersama, termasuk tinjauan masalah global dan keamanan saat ini, penanggulangan terorisme dan ekstremisme kekerasan, dan peningkatan kerja sama maritim, pertahanan, ruang angkasa, dan keamanan siber.

Menteri Mahfud dan Penasihat Keamanan Nasional Ajit Doval mengakui pentingnya hubungan persahabatan tradisional dan Kemitraan Strategis Komprehensif antara kedua negara dan menyatakan keyakinannya bahwa IISD akan memperkuat kerja sama di antara mereka untuk mengatasi tantangan bersama dan mengidentifikasi peluang untuk kolaborasi erat lebih lanjut di bidang masalah politik dan keamanan.

Dalam pertemuan tersebut, Menteri Mahfud dan Penasihat Keamanan Nasional Ajit Doval menandatangani Nota Kesepahaman Dialog Keamanan antara Kementerian Koordinator Bidang Politik, Hukum, dan Keamanan Republik Indonesia dengan Sekretariat Dewan Keamanan Nasional Republik India.

Penasihat Keamanan Nasional Ajit Doval menyampaikan terima kasih kepada Menteri Mahfud karena telah menjadi tuan rumah pertemuan di Indonesia dan menyampaikan undangan untuk menjamu Indonesia di India untuk menjadi co-chair IISD ke-3.

Penasihat Keamanan Nasional Ajit Doval juga bertemu dengan Menteri Koordinator Bidang Kemaritiman dan Investasi dan Menteri Luar Negeri.
