The international travel guidelines for foreigners arriving in India have been modified on account of COVID-19 pandemic. It applies to all foreigners including the visa seekers from Indonesia intending to visit India:

- I. People with 14 days' of travel history to Indonesia are barred from direct entry with immediate effect.
- II. Entry is allowed only with 14 days' stay/quarantine in a third country with RT-PCR test (within 72 hours prior to entry in India).
- III. Further, 8 days' institutional quarantine is mandatory on arrival in India.
- IV. In view of the above:
 - a) In case of diplomatic/official passport holder, visa application should accompany with diplomatic note providing information of departure and undertaking for abiding with all health-related protocols in India.
 - b) In case of ordinary passport holder, visa application should accompany with an undertaking providing information of departure and undertaking for abiding with all health-related protocols in India.
 - c) In both cases, the following need to be submitted along with the visa application form:
 - (i) Details of hotel booking for quarantine for a period of 8 x 24 hours upon arrival in India.
 - (ii) Itinerary of departure from Indonesia to third country for 14 days; and
 - (iii) Itinerary of departure from third country to India.
 - (iv) Production of Covid-19 vaccination certificate is mandatory upon arrival in India.
