## Documents required:

- Original Passport and NRIC/EP/WP card of both applicants and photo copies.
- Marriage certificate original and copy.
- Passport of the child, if applicable.
- Letter jointly signed expressing willingness to adopt, identifying the country of child to be adopted and undertaking stating that they are eligible to adopt (inter- country adoption) as per Central Adoption Resource Agency (India) guidelines.
- Letter from adoption agency.
