Visit of members of the National Economic Council (DEN) of Indonesia to India

The National Economic Council (DEN) of Indonesia, the body which provides strategic recommendations to the Indonesian government is currently visiting India from 17th March to 23 March 2025 to study India's Digital Public Infrastructure (DPI) policy and infrastructure. This comes in the backdrop of several initiatives discussed during the recent visit of Indonesia's President to India, including the signing of an MoU on Digital Cooperation.

The 10 member delegation would comprise the Executive Directors from DEN, senior officers from Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of National Development Planning, Ministry of Communications and Digital, Ministry of State Apparatus Empowerment and Bureaucratic Reform and Bank Indonesia.

The delegation is expected to meet with Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Mission, Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI), Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Ministry of Finance, International Institute of Information Technology (IIIT) Bangalore, Sahmati Foundation and visit an Aadhaar Kendra in the National Capital Region.

This visit will lay strong foundation for collaboration in sharing India's digital capacities with Indonesia like DPI and its related services/schemes & UPI for digital payments, areas which are largely unaddressed until today in Indonesia's policy and institutional framework.
