


Weather During February

In February, Jakarta remains in the wet season, experiencing hot and humid weather with frequent rain. Average temperatures during this month typically range from 24°C to 31°C (75°F to 88°F). Rainfall is at its peak, with precipitation levels often exceeding 300 mm (11.8 inches), making it one of the wettest months of the year. Humidity levels also stay high, often around 85% or more. While rain showers are frequent, particularly in the afternoons, occasional sunny periods do occur, but visitors should be prepared for heavy downpours and potentially waterlogged streets.

About FOREIGN EXCHANGE RATE

The Indonesian Rupiah (Rp) is the local currency used throughout the country. Its value fluctuates, typically ranging between 15,000 and 16,000 Rupiah per U.S. dollar. Having a basic understanding of the Rupiah will help you manage your finances more effectively during your stay in Indonesia.
